**INMATE TRANSPORT ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**

**IT IS ORDERED** that attorneys who intend to request the presence at trial, hearing or plea or trial docket of an inmate who is currently incarcerated in an Alabama Department of Corrections facility or county jail in another jurisdiction shall, within a reasonable time prior to the trial, hearing or docket, file a motion to transport the inmate and shall file a properly executed transport order for the Court's signature.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Court will not require the Sheriff of Escambia County, Alabama to transport inmates to the Escambia County Courthouse solely for attorney-client meetings where no trial, hearing or docket is scheduled.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that a copy of this Order shall be distributed to all members of the Escambia County Bar Association, shall be posted on the website for the 21<sup>st</sup> Judicial Circuit, and shall be maintained in the Circuit Clerk's Office.
